This included the trampoline, benches and mats.</p> <p>This enabled increased engagement through a wider/ varied curriculum.</p>
<p>Equipment update.</p> <p>£1,000</p>	<p>July 2024</p>	<p>Increased knowledge/ confidence/ skills of staff leading PE/ sport sessions.</p> <p>Increased engagement of pupils in physical activity.</p> <p>Provide broader experiences within PE/ Sport</p>	<p>Additional equipment purchased included rebounding frames, new handball equipment and restocking of tennis balls, badminton shuttles and fitness equipment.</p> <p>This enabled increased participation through a broader PE curriculum alongside different extra-curricular activities.</p>
<p>Development of cycling provision (to include balance bikes, adaptive bikes, and 'Bike-ability').</p> <p>£1,000</p>	<p>July 2024</p>	<p>Increased engagement of all pupils in physical activity.</p> <p>Increased profile of PE/ sport across the whole school.</p>	<p>Repair of an adapted bike took place enabling greater access to onsite cycling activities.</p>
<p>Additional swimming sessions.</p> <p>£1,400</p>	<p>July 2024</p>	<p>Increased engagement of all pupils in physical activity.</p> <p>Provide pupils with a broader experience within PE/ sport.</p>	<p>All pupils at SSSC had access to additional swimming sessions as part of the life skills curriculum.</p>
